



## Addressee: Academics, IPOs and NGOs

Paragraph #27 Session #6 (2007)

## Full Text

The Permanent Forum recommends that non-governmental organizations, indigenous peoples' organizations and academics undertake independent studies and investigations into the violations of indigenous peoples' land rights through illegal land expropriation and exploitation and into the issue of land, forestry, tourism and mining concessions, including:(a)Recommendations on how the rights of indigenous peoples can be legally protected;(b)The degree to which Governments ensure free, prior and informed consent of indigenous peoples in the approval of land concessions and mining exploration licences over their traditional lands and forests;(c)The role of other States in the promotion of agribusiness and extractive industries without the free, prior and informed consent of indigenous peoples;(d)The role of multinational agri-business and extractive industries; specifically, whether corporate social responsibilities have been fulfilled and social and environmental impact assessments have been undertaken prior to the commencement of development projects.
